

The *Plattsmouth Journal*: The big boxes of muskets, the property of John Fitzgerald, which have been stored away for years past in the Fitzgerald block, are being shipped to Lincoln to be used in arming a militia company of that city. These muskets are the remnants of a lot of 700 purchased by Mr. Fitzgerald over twenty years ago as armament for a party of Fenians, who were prepared to participate in the proposed Fenian invasion of Canada in 1868. Inroads have been made upon this well equipped armory for various purposes from time to time, the last occasion being the equipment of a militia company at Omaha two or three years since. The muskets remaining have never been unpacked.
